

## **CORPORATE ORDINARY MEMBERSHIP**

Corporate Ordinary membership shall consist of –

- 1. Corporate (Ordinary) members**
- 2. Branch (Ordinary) members**

### **1. Corporate (Ordinary) Members**

- 1.1 Corporate Ordinary members are companies or identifiable commercial entities (Sole Trader, Partnership, Pty Ltd, Ltd, etc) who possess an ABN, ACN or BRN and are carrying on business in the industry who make an application that is accepted by the Board for Corporate Ordinary membership of the CVIAQ.
- 1.2 Corporate Ordinary members will be further divided in the membership records of the company into the following classes:
  - 1.2.1 Manufacturer
  - 1.2.2 Distributor
  - 1.2.3 General
- 1.3 Manufacturer members are those companies primarily engaged in the manufacture and/or modification and/or importation and national distribution/representation of new commercial motor vehicles / trailers / commercial motor vehicle bodies and/or new components, equipment and accessories for commercial motor vehicles and/or trailers in Australia.

(A commercial motor vehicle is defined as a vehicle meeting the requirements of the *Motor Vehicle Standards Act* definition of a *Goods Vehicle* or *Omnibus*.)
- 1.4 Distributor members are those companies primarily engaged in the distribution and/or sale of new commercial motor vehicles / trailers / commercial motor vehicle bodies and/or new components, equipment and accessories for commercial motor vehicles and/or trailers.
- 1.5 General members are those companies previously admitted to Ordinary membership who do not meet the category requirements above (e.g. Warby Tools, PSA Media, Esanda Finance, Toll North) or those members that are currently Associate members and successfully apply to the board to become Ordinary members in the future who do not meet the category requirements above.

### **2. Branch (Ordinary) members**

- 2.1 Branch Ordinary members are wholly or majority owned subordinate branches/offices of a corporate ordinary member who makes an application that is accepted by the Board for their branch/es to be included as branch members. Branch members must have the same business name as their head office or the Board will make enquiries to ensure that the applicant company is a true branch of the parent business before accepting the membership application.
- 2.2 Branch Ordinary members, associate members, life members and honorary members are not entitled to vote except in the capacity of a duly appointed representative of a Corporate Ordinary member.



## **CORPORATE ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP**

Corporate Associate membership shall consist of –

- 1. Corporate (Associate) members**
- 2. Branch (Associate) members**

### **1. Corporate (Associate) members**

- 1.1 Heavy Vehicle Repairer (Mechanical/Body/Specialist)
- 1.2 Transport Operator
- 1.3 Engineering Consultant
- 1.4 Finance/Insurance/Legal
- 1.5 Media
- 1.6 Training & Education (RTO, GTO, AAC)
- 1.7 General

### **2. Branch (Associate) members**

- 2.1 Branch Associate members are wholly or majority owned subordinate branches/offices of a corporate Associate member who makes an application that is accepted by the Board for their branch/es to be included as branch members. Branch members must have the same business name as their head office or the Board will make enquiries to ensure that the applicant company is a true branch of the parent business before accepting the membership application.
- 2.2 Branch Associate members, associate members, life members and honorary members are not entitled to vote except in the capacity of a duly appointed representative of a Corporate Ordinary member.
