As many members have not previously visited the new CVIAQ offices the map below will assist.

From the Centenary Highway (M5) take the Sumners Road exit.

If approaching from the south take the Sumners Road exit and turn right into Sumners Rd at the roundabout and proceed to the next roundabout taking the second exit into Monier Road.

If approaching from the north take the Sumners Road exit and proceed to the roundabout taking the first exit into Monier Road.
